

ALGERIA

Algeria does not import fish and fish products. There is no market for seafood products in Algeria because the population can not afford the more expensive products, and the domestic Algerian fishery is capable of supplying domestic seafood requirements. Most of the people in Algeria live near the Mediterranean coastline and are supplied seafood products by local fishermen. The coastline along Algeria is very rich in seafood resources and receives very little fishing pressure. The Algerian government is presently examining proposals to develop the local fishery along the entire coastline.
