The Five have now completed their initial consideration of possible constitutional principles for the Constituent Assembly. The Five believe that these proposals would be likely to secure the confidence of all concerned. Accordingly, the Five now intend to begin discussion of these proposed constitutional principles, as well as a timetable and an approach to other remaining issues with the parties concerned starting in October.

The Foreign Ministers recognize and share the desire of the international community to see early and meaningful progress towards the implementation of the United Nations plan and the independence of Namibia. They reaffirm their determination to pursue their efforts in cooperation with the parties concerned to resolve the remaining outstanding issues and thus secure without further delay a peaceful solution to the Namibian problem.
