Page 6, add new clause " 18 ":
"Application. 18. This Act shall not apply to any province unless the licensing body thereof has, by resolution, requested such application thereto."

The House resumed debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Caron, seconded by Mr. Rock,-That the Second Report of the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections, presented to this House on Wednesday, October 9, 1963, be now concurred in;

And on the proposed motion of Mr. Knowles, seconded by Mr. Brewin, in amendment thereto,-That the Second Report of the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections be not now concurred in but that it be referred back to the said Committee with instruction to amend it so as to recommend that Members of the opposition who belong to groups other than the Official Opposition be seated in the House according to the numerical strength of their respective groups.
