4. Schedule III to the said Act, as enacted by section seven of chapter fifty-two of the statutes of 1938 and 5 amended by section four of chapter fifty-two of the statutes of 1939 (1st session), is further amended:

(a) by striking out under the heading of "Foodstuffs" in the sixth line the words "Fish and products thereof;" and replacing them by the following words: "Fish and 10 products thereof, not to include canned fish;"

(b) by striking out under the heading of "Foodstuffs" in the tenth and eleventh lines the words: "Meats, salted or smoked (not to include the same when chopped, ground, parboiled or spiced);" 15

(c) by striking out under the heading of "Miscellaneous" in the first line the word "Electricity;" and replacing it by the following words: "Electricity, except when used in dwellings;"

(d) by striking out under the heading of "Miscellaneous" 20 in the fourth and fifth lines the words: "Gas manufactured from coal, calcium carbide or oil for illuminating or heating purposes;" and replacing them by the following words: "Natural gas and gas manufactured from coal, calcium carbide or oil for illuminating 25 or heating purposes except when used in dwellings;"

Coming
into force.

5. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the twelfth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine and to have applied to all goods mentioned therein imported or taken out of warehouse for consumption 30 on and after that date, and to have applied to goods previously imported for which no entry for consumption was made before that date.
