the lifetime of his four children, William, Mary, Eliza and Maria: and bequeathed the usufruct of his estate to his said four children, and the property to the lawful issues of these children. But should those children die leaving no lawful issue, then the whole estate was bequeathed to the Principals ex officio of the following Colleges and Universities: - Morrin College, Quebec, Dalhousie College, Halifax; University of Bishop's College, Lennozville; McGill University, Montreal; Queen's University, Kingston; Toronto University, Toronto; and Manitoba College, Manitoba; and to the Moderator of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, ex officio, in trust, to form a fund and invest and administer the same for scholarships or bursaries; 2.- Said Robert Bruce departed this life on the fourth day of October eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, without revoking or modifying his above mentioned will; 3 .- All the children of the said Robert Burce are now dead, the last one, Mrs. Nelson, having departed this life on the twentyseventh day of September last, and none of said children left lawful issue; 4.- The appearers are now entitled to enter into possession of said estate and administer and dispose of same, the whole according to the terms of said will; 5.- In order to receive the securities and monies belonging to said estate and which now form part of said Trust (The Robert Bruce Bursaries or Scholarships), to give a final acquittance and dis-

5.- In order to receive the securities and monies belonging to said estate and which now form part of said Trust (The Robert Bruce Bursaries or Scholarships), to give a final acquittance and discharge to the executors of the will and to sign the documents necessary to put the assets of the estate in the name of the trustees, it is expedient that one of the appearers should be appointed as Attorney;

6.- The appearers living at a large distance from each other, the administration of said assets might be difficult, and would involve large expenditures should frequent meetings be held;
