
Report of a Committee on Honorary Degrees.

The Committee recommends unanimously that there shall be one, and only one, Honorary Degree, namely that of Doctor of Laws, as set forth in Chapter XI of the Statutes of McGill University, (p. 87).

The Committee further recommends that Corporation abolish the Honorary Degree of Master of Arts, (Statutes, Chapter XI, section 2), on the principle that no Honorary Degree should ever be given when the same title of degree is awarded by examination, thesis, or published work.

The Honorary Degree of Doctor of Laws, should, as heretofore, be conferred on those, whether or not McGill graduates, who have conspicuous merit or have rendered pre-eminent service in any subject, profession, occupation, or walk of life.
