

The two last are placed just in the center of our *French* settlements, which effectually keeps the inhabitants in awe. At the head of the bay of *Fundy*, between that and the bay of *Vert*, upon a narrow isthmus, of but a few miles across, is the garrison of *Chebecoetzo*, where they have about eight hundred men in garrison. As this isthmus is very narrow, which the *Indians* must pass to come at any of our settlements, (which are all upon the peninsula) this fort deters them greatly from coming down upon our settlements, for
