on the Eaftern and Northern creeks and rivers called Logwood Rivers on the bay of Campechy, all the tracts poffeffed on the bay of Honduras, or Eaft fide of Yucatan, and the Mofquito kingdom, were clearly and fully confirmed.

In the year 1680, his Catholic Majefty Charles II. by another treaty of peace and friendship, renewed and confirmed that of 1670, with his Britannic Majesty Charles II.

The Treaty of Utrecht in 1713, fallacioufly mentioned in the late Spanifh manifefto, and feveral times fince by the Spanifh advocates in the daily papers, as extending the territorial claims of the crown of Spain in America, in truth, by articles 8th and 15th, only confirms equally the territorial rights of both crowns in America, the fame as fettled by the treaties of 1670 and 1680; that is, navigation, commerce, and the poffeffions of Great-Britain and Spain are B 2 Continued
