**A FIRE AND A COLLAPSE.**

Destroyed at Fall River.

Fall River, Mass., Dec. 16.—An early morning fire here destroyed the St. James' Hotel, gutted the shoe store of Police Commissioner Stanton and the department store of Quinn, Woodland & Company, resulting a loss of \$45,000; partially insured.

The north side of the hotel fell out into the street and completely demolished a fire truck. The front of the hotel on South Main-street, bringing down the telegraph, telephone and electric light wires, and completely tying up the electric car service.

While leaning over the fire, the flames reached his coat, and soon his clothes were ablaze. He hastily disrobed, and was successful in extinguishing the flames.
