THE CAMPERS MUST MOVE CASE OF REV. DR. HUNTER

Island Committee Endorses the New Camping Ground Selected By A. Burns on the Island.

TO BE REACHED BY A CHAIN FERRY

A Lively Discussion in Council Will Likely Result—Notes From the City Hall.

Contrary to custom, the Island Committee had a quorum yesterday afternoon. The chief matter for discussion related to the question of the removal of campers and occupants of small cottages from the city property adjoining Halton's Point, and it was decided to clean them all out and locate them on a site between the settling basin and the new cut to the west of the present site on Blackhawk Bay. There is a channel nearly 80 feet wide to the west of the settling basin, and it will be recommended that \$100 be spent on a scow or chain ferry in order that the campers may get across.

The above was adopted on the motion of Ald. Woods, who thought it was the best solution of the difficulty. If it passes the Council, it will mean that all the campers on the Heber property must move out at once to the new site and take their tents or shacks with them. There is, however, a possibility that the committee's recommendation will be vigorously opposed by Ald. Loudon, Richardson, Ward, Frame and others. At the meeting yesterday afternoon, Ald. Richardson moved, in amendment to Ald. Woods, that the campers be given a lease of their property and be allowed to remain where they are for this season, on the understanding that they must get into the new location by the end of the season.
