Favors Electrocution.



Judge Macbeth complimented the jurors, under Forman F. E. Harley, for their good work, and promised to forward the recommendations to the proper authorities for consideration. He stated that he was glad that capital punishment had not been carried out in this county for years, and hoped that it would never be necessary to again inflict the death penalty in this district. Having completed their duties for the June session of the county court, the grand jury was then discharged by Judge Maobeth.
