Re: Rex vs Samuel Dodge

I enclose herewith my account, in triplicate, with voucher for disbursements attached for services rendered, herein, up to the time of your withdrawal from the defence.

Several days before the trial Mr. Frank W. Curran, of London, who was retained by the Accused, requested me to attend and assist him with the trial. As the Accused was charged with murder and I was, through my connection with the case, familiar with the whole situation, I felt it my duty to do so. Accordingly I obtained your permission to attend. The trial opened on Tuesday morning, November 5, and finished on Thursday evening, November 7.

The Accused was acquitted and discharged from custody.
