ATLANTIC GALE TAKES HEAVY TOLL OF LIVES. The heavy gale along the Atlantic coast on Saturday and Sunday was responsible for the loss of a large number of lives. It is feared that the steamer Prins Mauritius of the Royal Dutch West India Company has sunk with her crew of forty-five and four passengers. While off Cape Hatteras she sent out a wireless call for help and later reported she was sinking fast. Other steamers which went to her assistance could find no trace of her. Fifteen men are believed to have lost their lives last night when the tug Edward Luckenbach founded off Cape Cape, Va. The first and second officers were saved and five bodies have been recovered. Ten seamen of the crews of the Consolidated Coal Company's barges, 6 and 9, were drowned on Saturday when the barges founded off the Delaware Capes.
