LONG ROMANCE OF LOST DAUGHTER

London Girl Finds Parents
After Ten Years' Absence.

London, Ont., Nov. 27.—The restoration of a 15-year-old girl to her parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Hall, of 378 Ottawa Avenue, has brought about through a series of strange circumstances, after a separation of more than ten years. The girl, a small child, was placed in the custody of the Children's Aid Society, rebelliously she ran away three times before Inspector Saunders finally managed to place her out for adoption. She was given into the care of a family and removed with her parents to Niagara Falls, N. Y., where she lived for a few days. She then came to this city on a visit. By chance while at a theatre, she picked up acquaintance with Mrs. John Hall, of 380 Ottawa Avenue, and was in the city for a few days. The girl, who lived next door, became acquainted with her under the name of adopted parents, but were strangers to her. Mrs. Hall had a frantic search for her child after removal from London, but she never been able to trace her further. Niagara Falls. The girl's mother, and brother in turn commented on the familiarity of her appearance, at length questioned her, tracing her life back to the day when she was taken from her parents by the Children's Aid Society. Her identity was finally established by a peculiar vaccination mark on the girl's arm, which she explained to her mother as being a mark of a girl who had been vaccinated by the Children's Aid Society. "It all seems real now," she said, "and I am very happy."

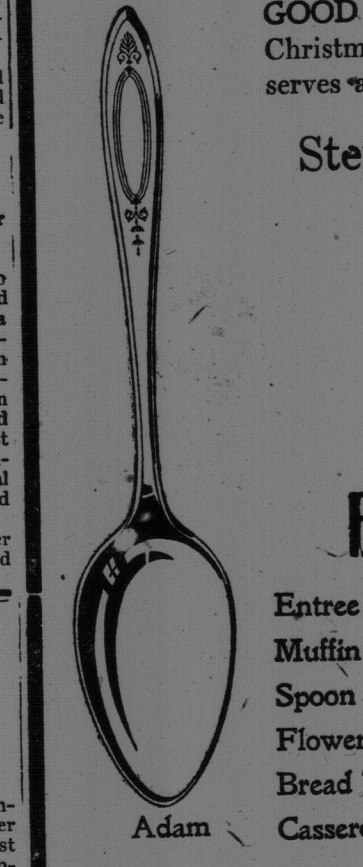
