CAMPAIGN

SWISS CHARD.

There is one vegetable not yet mentioned in this series and very little known to Canadians, that should really take a prominent place in the war time garden, that is to say, Swiss Chard. It is a succulent vegetable, easy to grow, easy to cook, easy to can. No vegetable gives more bountiful returns for a small amount of labor or offers a greater variety of uses. A row twenty feet long planted about this time will give an abundant supply for a family of five for the whole season if only the outer ribs are cut each time and the remainder of the plant is left to grow.

With the price of asparagus out of reach of ordinary mortals, Swiss Chard is really an excellent substitute. It can be served as a hot vegetable with sauce, or as a salad with French dressing or mayonnaise. The young leaves can be cooked in the same way as spinach and the largest ribs cut in small pieces and cooked like celery. Or again, they can be cut in five-inch pieces, boiled for from twelve to fifteen minutes and chilled before serving.


