(Times' Special Correspondence) London, Sept. 4.—Almost every country in the world has had an exhibition in London, devoted to its resources, but we have to go back a good many years since a purely British exhibition opened its gates in the metropolis. This is to be altered, and for the last twelve months plans have been in course of preparation, for the imperial exhibition to be held in 1915, which is to bring together everything of British industry and resource from all parts of the empire.

IRISH EMIGRANTS FOR THE DOMINION Plan to Divert Workers From The United States THE CALL AT QUEENSTOWN

Next Month to See a Beginning of The Work at Blacksod Bay, Looking To The Three and a Half Day Run To Canada

(Times' Special Correspondence) London, Sept. 4.—Whatever the result of the decision of the Canadian Line to discontinue the calls of their fast American steamers at Queenstown may be to Ireland, it will probably mean a great deal to Canada, for it is the intention of the company to have steamers of the Canadian service make a stop at the southern Irish port.

Following the current of the initial stream emigration from Ireland has flowed to the United States, and though the principal reason for this is general known, it is certain that the fact of Canadian steamers making no call at Queenstown was a strong secondary feature. With regular callings at this port, there would be a revival of Irish emigration to Canada, for, where ever the sailing bill flourishes, the settlement is found, and in spite of the opposition to emigration in Ireland, there will be plenty of people willing to cross instead of New York.

Next month a beginning will be made of another shipping development of importance to Canada. As the nearest harbor to the dominion of any in the British Isles, Blacksod Bay, on the west coast of Ireland is likely to command a good deal of public interest. Work on this much talked of deep water harbor, and the new railway connecting it with other Irish lines will be in full swing soon.

The bay is one of the most sheltered spots on the whole of the west coast of Ireland. A natural breakwater extending for about twelve miles, receives the full force of the Atlantic, and on its other side forms a sheltered area nine miles long and three or four miles wide. Halifax can be reached in three and a half days by twenty-five knot vessels, and one of the advantages claimed for the new route is that steamers can run at the maximum speed from the moment they leave the Irish harbor until they reach Halifax, the delays and difficulties of channel navigation and waiting for tides being avoided.
