LETTUCE SALAD WITH
FRIED CHEESE Dress the lettuce in the usual way with French dressing. Have a mild cheese, rather dry, cut in strips like French fried potatoes, dip the strips in beaten eggs, roll on bread crumbs and drop into fat to brown quickly. Serve with lettuce.

HAM SALAD.

Put one pound of cold boiled ham through a meat chopper. Add half dozen small pickles, chopped, and a little chopped celery. Dress with a good salad dressing and serve on fresh lettuce. STRING BEAN SALAD.

Take crisp lettuce leaves (four are plenty), arrange them in roses, put one large spoonful of cold string beans in each rose, cover with a cream salad dressing and dot all over with little squares of boiled beets. on ice till ready to serve.
