be exalted in that day." Therefore, Brethren, enlist hear and hand in the cause of God, and if the world should offer to you its temptations, in order to draw off your attention from his work resist it, replying as Nehemiah did when requested to desist from the re-building of the walls of Jerusa lem, "I am doing a great work so that I cannot come down." Resist the temptations of satan with the same prompt and de cisive answer, for what shall it profit a man if he should gain the whole world and lose his own soul, or what shall a ma give in exchange for his soul. We rejoice to record that death has not been permitted to thin our ranks during the pas year, but that each Minister appeared to enjoy both physics and spiritual health.

During the past year we have had trials to pass through a painful and disagreeable nature, principally through the bas conduct of some of our Ministers who betrayed the trust con mitted to them, one of whom has embraced gross and fatale rors, and has denied the Lord who bought him. These occu rences we deplore, still the God who is on our side is mor than all that can be against us. Therefore, Brethren, gird ory for ever the lions of your mind, be sober and hope to the end, if yo are faithful to God and the cause of divine truth, your difficu ties will vanish and your way will be made plain before yo

We were much pleased with the intelligence which has con from many Circuits that several neat, commodious and con fortable houses have been erected for the worship of Go We rejoice in this, for we consider it a plain indication of growth of piety amongst our people, and as calculated in high degree to advance the interests of our Zion. great-head of the Church bless our friends in their work faith and labour of love.

We are happy also to state, that some of our Circuits ha been actively engaged in erecting parsonage houses, and trust that others will catch a spark of the same fire and deayour to place their Ministers in such circumstances as enable them to devote their energies, time and talents, to great work of saving souls.
