While the death of King Edward would have little direct bearing on the local situation the financial affairs of the country and of England are so closely interwoven that the indirect or sympathetic effect of a decline in the London market from the cause might be very considerable. Eventually our market would break away from this influence, but the declines in prices would be caused from declines in London. Under normal conditions the technical position of this market would favor some further recovery.
