## NEW STEEL MERGER HAS ORE IN ABUNDANCE

Commences Its Existence With 4,000,000,000 Tons, or Five Times as Much as Possessed by U. S. Steel When it Started in 1901.

Montreal, May 16.—(Canadian Press)—Prior to his departure for New York, Saturday, Colonel W. Grant Morden stated that the preliminary balance sheet of the \$500,000,000 British Empire Steel Corporation, which will shortly be available for analysis, exhibits an interesting contrast with the balance sheet of the United States Steel Corporation. The only larger organization in the industry, in the direction of conservative capitalization, as compared with actual assets, of the limitation of indebtedness, and of the provision of ample working capital. "No addition," he said, "is to be made by the consolidation to the funded debt of the various constituent companies which will thus remain at slightly over \$400,000,000. Of the total capitalization, therefore, less than 1 1/2 per cent. is in the form of bonds. The appraised valuation of the fixed properties of the British Empire Corporation is no less than \$400,000,000, of which nearly \$200,000,000 is not offset by any capital driven farm equipment. The ratio of mortgage debt to mortgageable properties is less than 11 per cent."
