New York, Nov. 4.—Dr. Sao-Ke Alfred Sze, Chinese Minister to the United States, delivered an address at Columbia University last night in which he made direct reference to Chima's attitude toward the coming Washington conference on problems S of the Far East.

"The development of China," said Dr. Sze, "if properly directed can be a great world benefit; if improperly interfered with, it may become a world menace. There are two ways of obtaining supplies from China. One way is accomplished by force to the upbuilding of something which the world war demonstrated cannot exist in the modern world. The other way is through Chinese self-development that will benefit the whole world, ourselves along with you.
