SAVARY, Alfred William, *M. A.* [*Digby.*] L.

A branch of the family, which is of Huguenot extraction, migrated from Devonshire, Eng., to Massachusetts in the earliest period of the history of that colony. Great grandfather removed to N. S. S. of Sabine Savary, Esq., of Plympton, N. S. B. there 1831. Ed. at University of King's College, Windsor, N. S., where he took degree of M. A. Unmarried. Is a Barrister at Law, N. S.
