In case of a Poll being so demanded, the Returning Officer for cach Electoral Division, in such township, shall cause a Poll to be opened at the Polling place appointed in such Division, on the first Monday in January following, and shall take the votes in the same way and keep the Poll open for the full time required by law for taking the votes, in 5 cases where no Electoral Division shall be established.
- Poll-books to S. Every Returning Officer shall, on the day after the close of the bereturned to Poll, return the Poll-Book to the township clerk, verified under oath the Township before the said clerk, or any Justice of the Peace for the county or union of counties in which the said township may lie, as to the due and 10 correct taking of the votes for the said Electoral Division.
- Township Clerk shall add up the number of votes set down clerk to add up votes and declare result gate number of votes, and shall at the Township Hall, or such other of election.
