## Weinburger spills guts to "People"

U.S. Secretary of Defense Caspar Weinberger recently admitted that he personally didn't understand what all this militarism and sabre rattling is all about.

"I don't know why Reagan and Haig keep giving us so much money," he said in a taped interview with *People* magazine.

"We've got so much money for arms spending now that we are having to get into horrible things like binary chemical warheads—those things are dangerous, you know," he said.

Weinberger's unflattering statements about the Reagan administration come in the wake of Budget Director Dapid Stockman's controversial inter-

view with *Atlantic Monthly*, in which he said the Reagan economic recovery program was a whitewash to give more tax breaks to the rich.

The White House has not yet responded to Weinberger's allegations. Speculation is that Reagan may send both Stockman and Weinberger to work camps in Wyoming.

Wayne Gretzky wrote reviews of books and classical music four years before being born and deciding to embark on the career for which he is now justifiably famous.

The 1960s was the time of

the Free Speech Movement in Berkeley, California. In Edmonton, nothing of the sort happened; of primary interest was coach Clare DeLune's heading up intercollegiate-championship teams in both frisbee and mouse-

gutting.

Most of you remember the '70s, right? The most controversial period of that decade was the year the *Getaway* went on strike to protest an attempt by Students' Council to impose some standards of quality and ethics on the staff. The result was the suspension of the paper by the Canadian University Press (CUP), and the formation of a CUP-sanctioned underground newspaper, the *Pud-pounder*. Most of the people who worked for this paper are now dead or serving time in federal penitentiaries.

Since the early '70s, the paper has devoted its pages to the study of such issues as women's rights, U.S. repression in South-East Asia, women's rights, U.S. oppression in Central America, women's rights, and U.S. repression everywhere else. Other issues covered include earwax and how generally rotten all engineers everywhere are.

This brings us up to the 1980s. Unfortunately, what with last night's announcement, it doesn't look as if there's going to be much of a 1980's for the *Getaway* to report.

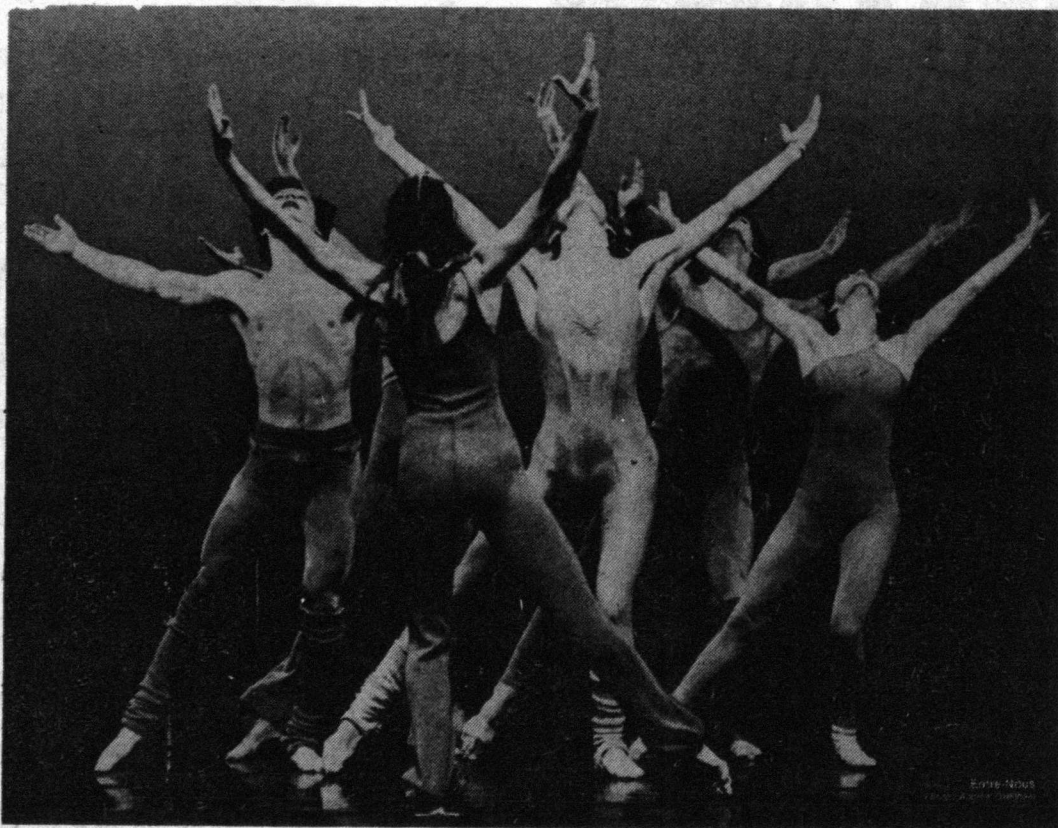
