Yours of the 31st December last N^o 157414, Acknowledging the Receipt of mine of the 26 of the same month, enclosing an Application from Mr Benjamin Young to purchase Lot 33, Con 1, M.B.R. St Edmund (100 acres) Under Section 6 of the Land Regulations, and in reply I have to inform you that you may authorize a Forest Bailiff to examine this Lot, provided the cost of such examination is paid in advance by the Applicant, (ccina).

In reply I have the honor to say that I send herewith the Forest Bailiff Report on and valuation of the above mentioned Lot, said valuation being the sum of \$25⁰⁰ Cash free of conditions.

The 5 or 6 acres of good land reported to be on the Lot in question and along side of the Bury Road and a portion of it cleared and cropped by the Applicant Mr Benjamin Young living in the neighborhood of said Lot. and consequently ^{the good land} can be made available by Mr Young. I would place the sum of \$30⁰⁰ value thereon.

The Bailiff is well acquainted with your Abd^t Servant this Lot for years, and I have passed ^{Mr} Simpson by it several times.
