SIR:

Referring to the Erection of a stable and fence at the new Roman Catholic Church for the Roman Catholic portion of the Band of the Tape Tokes Indian Reserve.

I Enclose a Resolution of the Indian Council and Band in Council held on the 14th. instant at which they voted \$ 325.⁰⁰ Three hundred and twenty five dollars for the purpose mentioned. Two of the Indian Councillors agree to erect the stable, furnish all the material, and every thing complete for the sum of (\$ 250.⁰⁰) Two hundred and fifty dollars, viz. - Chas Jones and Peter Taylor. I have to say that for Indians, and even white men could not find better carpenters and handy men for rough work of this kind, and I recommend that they get the job. They expect me to go their security for the material needed if the Partner who have the material to sell refuse them credit, until the cheque for payment is received.

I Enclose a sketch of Specification made by Mr John Redridge of Hepworth, a friend of Rev. Father Cadott, the Parish Priest.

Mr Taylor and Mr Jones tell me there was no provision made for sleepers and flooring in the sketch. They will have to go to the bank for those sleepers and buy plank for flooring.
