Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that in pursuance of the determination of the Administration to effect a reduction in the cost of management of Indian affairs, the following changes are to be made in the staff of the Sarcee Agency, immediately upon your successor assuming charge thereof, on 1st June next.

The clerkship of the Agency is to be abolished from the date mentioned and Mr. Tynte is being today advised to this effect. Be good enough to see that the office work is all brought up to that date.

From the same date the wages of Interpreter Geo. Hodgson will be reduced to \$30. per month, of which please give him immediate notice.
