1 shall have the same meanings as are ascribed to them by section
2 seven hundred one. All of the provisions of article twenty relating
3 to the administration and enforcement thereof and the judicial
4 enforcement and review of decisions made in proceedings instituted
5 thereunder, so far as the same are or can be made applicable, and
6 are not inconsistent with the provisions of this article, shall apply
7 to the administration and enforcement of the provisions of this
8 article and the judicial enforcement and review of decisions made
9 in proceedings instituted hereunder with the same force and effect
10 as if they were fully set forth and incorporated in this article.

11 § 727. Right of members of labor organizations to participate
12 in strike votes. No strike shall hereafter be deemed authorized
13 unless it has been approved by the votes of a majority of the mem-
14 bers of the labor organization involved cast, by secret ballot, at
15 an election held under the supervision of and in accordance with the
16 rules and regulations of the board.

17 § 728. Certain strikes unlawful; suspension of certification as
18 approved labor representative. It shall be unlawful to hold or
19 conduct any strike in violation of a judgment, decree or order of
20 any court or other tribunal having jurisdiction of a labor dispute
21 and, in addition to any other penalty now or hereafter authorized
22 or provided therefor, by law or otherwise, the board shall suspend
23 the certification as approved labor representative of the labor
24 organization responsible for such strike, which suspension shall
25 continue in effect for and during the period of such strike.

26 § 729. Liability of labor organizations for damages. A labor
27 organization shall be liable for and may be sued in any court of
