DISPUTE BETWEEN ETHIOPIA AND ITALY.

Communication from the Ethiopian Government.

(Translation)

Geneva, April 13th, 1936.

To the Secretary-General.

The Ethiopian Delegation has the honour to transmit to Your Excellency for immediate communication to the Committee of Thirteen, the Committee of Eighteen, the Council and all the Members of the League of Nations the following telegram dated April 12th, 1936, which has just been received from the Ethiopian Government:

"Herewith list, with dates, of the towns attacked with poison gas:

Takkaze Amba Alaa Borena Sokota Makale Megalo

Waldia Road, Kworam Ylanserer Kworam Irga Alem Indomahoni Kworam December 22nd, 1935. December 26th, 1935. December 31st, 1935 January 10th, 1936 January 21st, 1936 February, 1936 (as the date cannot be exactly deciphered confirmation has been asked for). February 27th, 1936 March 16th, 1936 March 17th, 1936 March 17th, 1936. March 19th and 21st, 1936. March 29th and 30th, 1936. April 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 1936.

During these last four bombardments of Kworam (April 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 1936), the town was literally drenched with gas. The gas most frequently used is mustard gas (yperite).
