

With Cheque

Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 7th instant, I beg to enclose herewith accountable cheque No. 4823 for \$100.00 being an advance wherewith to defray expenses connected with the construction of a telephone line on the Mid Lake Reserve. You should pay the men who worked from the proceeds of this cheque. The Department is sending under separate cover, a supply of labor return forms upon which you should submit returns in duplicate of the work done. Each man who worked should receipt for the amount paid him, in the column provided for the purpose. If any of the Indians cannot write, they should sign by mark and the signatures in every case should be witnessed by a third disinterested person. The witness should sign at the foot of the form in the place provided for the purpose.
