Memorandum for W. J. Turnbull

Recently I got information about various "private enterprise" groups. I thought you would like to have a note about these.

- (1) J.S. Duncan said to have a considerable fund which he administers for the purpose.
- (2) Woodward of Vancouver is said to have raised money in the west for the same purpose.
- (3) Fort Erie Times - Review said to be backed by Johnson and P.C. Armstrong of the C.P.R. at a paid up circulation of under 1000 but distributes tens of thousands of copies.
- (4) W. A. Lawrence, Publicity counsel of Montreal acts for a number of separate firms. Most of the publicity agents are doing similar work.
- (5) Gladstone Murray has an office in the Victory Building, Toronto. In the same building are Samuel Rogers, K.C., and Joe Sedgewick, K.C. Rogers is said to handle Murray's funds for him. These funds have been contributed by
