Q I produce this document from your custody. Will you
identify it?

A M.F.B. 216, Certificate of apprehension by or surrender
to service authorities, relating to the accused.

M.F.B. 216, READ, MARKED EXHIBIT "H" SIGNED BY THE
PRESIDENT AND ATTACHED TO THE PROCEEDINGS.

Q I produce this document from your custody. Will you
identify it?

A M.F.B. 1481, certificate of cost of transportation,
relating to the accused.

PRESIDENT: This M.F.B. 1481 refers to transportation
from LaSalle to Windsor. As the accused was apprehended
at Windsor there is nothing in the charge to indicate
any reason for the cost of this transportation.
The document is therefore rejected.
