

to speak shall have spoken, unless the member wishes to explain a material part of his speech, which may have been misconceived or misunderstood, but then he is not to introduce any new matter.

XX.

When a motion has once been made, and carried in the affirmative or negative, it shall be in order for any member to move for a re-consideration; and if, such motion is seconded, it shall be open to debate, and be disposed of by the Council; and in case the motion be made at the same meeting, it shall be competent for a majority of the members present to pass a vote of re-consideration; but if it be not made until the next meeting, the subject shall not be re-considered, unless a majority of the whole Council shall vote therefor; but no more than one motion for the re-consideration of any vote shall be permitted.

XXI.

Whenever it shall be moved, and carried, that the Council shall go into Committee of the whole, the Mayor shall leave the chair, and the Council in Committee shall appoint a chairman of the Committee of the whole, who shall report the proceedings of the Committee. The rules of proceeding in Council, shall be observed in committee of the whole, so far as they may be applicable, except the rule limiting the times of speaking, and the taking of the
