

On bonds. bonds and security be continued. And all Sums of Money due for interest, shall be prosecuted for at the first Term of His Majesty's Court of King's Bench, happening after the same shall have become due.

ART. 14. All arrears of Monthly contributions shall be prosecuted for at the next Term of the Court of King's Bench, after such arrears shall have amounted to more than the contributions for one year.

ART. 15. When any Member who shall have paid his Monthly contribution for two years, shall be unable to follow his profession, trade, or ordinary occupation, either on account of sickness, lameness, blindness, age or other infirmity whatsoever, or by being prisoner with the enemy, he shall be entitled to receive out of the funds of the Society, if he require it, the sum of Twenty Shillings weekly, during the first twelve weeks of such incapacity, and Ten Shillings weekly during the remainder thereof.

ART. 16. Upon the death of the Wife of a Member, having contributed as aforesaid, there shall be paid to such Member, if he require it, Ten
