MARCH.—Finish winter jobs before the driving work of the spring⁴ begins. Have all your implements in readiness for the approaching 6 season. Plows, carts, harrows, rakes and other tools should be put into good order; if not, your work will be hindered. Put and keep things in their proper places, that men and horses may not stand idle. Draw firewood, cut it up and house it, that good dry wood may be always at hand, and the women folks kept from scolding. Wet wood is an abomination, causing smoke in the kitchen, soreness in the eyes, sour bread, and meals delayed. Pay good attention to cows with young calves.
