BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. There be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the Province for the services hereinafter mentioned, the following sums, viz:—

To the Chaplain of the Legislative Council in General As-

sembly, twenty pounds.

To the Chaplain of the House of Assembly, twenty pounds. To the Sergeant at Arms attending the Legislative Council in General Assembly, fifteen shillings per diem during the present Session.

To the Sergeant at Arms attending the House of Assembly,

fifteen shillings per diem during the present Session.

To the Clerk of the Legislative Council in General Assembly, two hundred pounds in full for his services during the present Session.

To the Clerk of the House of Assembly, two hundred pounds

for his services during the present Session.

To the Clerk Assistant of the Legislative Council in General Assembly, one hundred pounds in full for his services during the present Session.

To the Clerk Assistant of the House of Assembly, one hun-

dred pounds for his services during the present Session.
