section of the Act 16th Vic. Cap 14, and the 11th
section of the Act 27th Vic. Cap 37, expressly
provide that when the lands comprised in any
one information, for recovery of land assessment,
shall not exceed 500 acres, the costs to be taxed,
thereon, shall not exceed the sum of three pounds,
including Attorney-General's, Prothonotory's and
Judge's tees, and all other costs of Court. More-
over, Sir, by the same Acts, it will be seen that
no information can be fyled against any island in-
cluded in any of the Townships; and, therefore,
the whole of the proceedings against the said is-
land were contrary to all or any law. I will
now, Sir, with your permission, read over another
bill of costs, being in the case of James Stewart,
against Francis McQuade, Edward Lane, and
John Scott McLeod, in which, if you don't agree
with me that there are many useless forms and fic-
tions which ought to be done away with, I shall
be much mistaken, and at the evening session of
this House, if the House will permit, the Commit-
tee will be prepared to furnish what will fully
satisfy, for the necessity of the reform prayed for.
