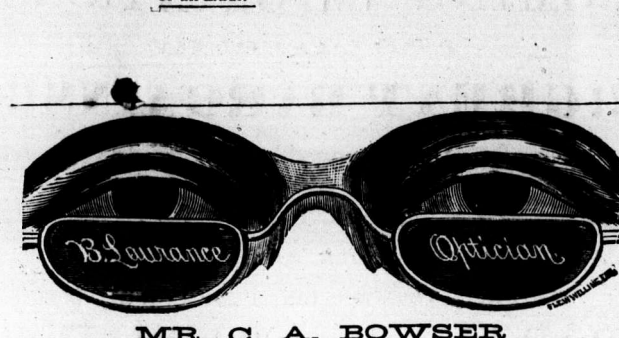

New Hotel.—Messrs. Geo. B. Estabrook & Sons have commenced the rebuilding of the Brunswick House, recently destroyed by fire. A contract has been entered into with Mr. J. H. Brown, the contractor, for its immediate construction, and they expect, from Mr. Teed's resources, facilities and well-known character for dispatch, to have it finished by the beginning of the year. The new building will be the much larger than the old one, being ninety feet in length, and with mansard roof, three stories high, and an ell 45 feet long in the rear.
