OUR FORESTS

They Are The Provinces Most Valuable Asset And Must Be Protected

FORESTRY ASS. MEETS

Province Is In Need Of Fire Warden: And Stricter Regulations

(Fredericton Gleaner)

Lt. Col. Loggie, has returned from the sixth annual meeting of the Canadian Forestry Association where he represented the province of New Brunswick and read a paper entitled The Forests of New-Brunswick. This paper proved to be one of the most interesting of the meeting and was thoroughly discussed by those in attendance.

Among those whom Lt. Col. Loggie, mentions who were in attendance are Dr. Shank, of Eiltmore North Carolina, and another gentleman who hails from Ann Arbor Michigan, where he is now connected with a Forestry School there.

Dr. Shank, is in the employ of the Vanderbilts, being their expert in forestry. He was brought out from Germany by the Vanderbilts, and in his native land he was considered the best informed man regarding forestry.

Dr. Shank, was much interested in Lt. Col. Loggie's paper and another who displayed a great deal of interest in the paper was the Chief Fire Warden of New York State.

All the provinces of the Dominion were represented except Nova Scotia, Manitoba and Prince Edward Island.

The principal subject under discussion was naturally Fire Ranging and as an outcome of what was heard there by Lt. Col. Loggie and the feeling that has existed throughout the length and breadth of the province, especially among those who have a study of forestry it would not be surprising to see some changes made in the laws of New Brunswick in reference to this important matter.

Lt. Col. Loggie, in conversation with a reporter this morning stated as this province's most valuable asset was its forests it would have to take every move necessary to protect them. From what he could learn at the meeting that he had just attended this province had been very lucky in regard to forest fires. It must be remembered that for 100 miles north of Boiestown right up to Campbellton there is nothing outside of a green forest country and this must be protected.

What the province wants, according to what Lt. Col. Loggie could learn at the meeting, is a law to cause the appointment of fire wardens for the different districts and then to prohibit the setting of fires without first of all obtaining the permission of one of the wardens in writing.

During the meeting at Quebec a telegram was read from Senator Edwards in which it was stated that the Prime Minister, Sir. Wilfrid Laurier, had asked him to wire stating that it was the intention to have a special forestry meeting at Ottawa next fall when representatives from all over the continent would be present.

Lt. Col. Loggie spoke in glowing terms of the excellence of the entertainments provided for the delegates by the lumbermen and bankers of Quebec at the Chateau Frontenac and also by the ladies at Montmorency.
