B., wheat middlings more popular than bran, but he preferred bran. Oil cake and cotten seed lighten the ration and their digestion. Oats are good feed, but very expensive. The bye-product of distilleries is by far the best feed, but the demand for it is so great that few can obtain it.

In the fall the plants should be cover-d with brush or straw to keep them from freezing in the spring. The octagnal box is the best shape for shipping straw-berries. Two years is long emough to rur the same plants. Raspberries need a moist, cool soil, and will not stand the heat like strawberries. A light clay loam, or a fairly heavy sand soil is best.
