There is now a standard-gauge railroad from Cairo to Jerusalem with regular freight and passenger trains daily. Likewise, nearly ten thousand natives -men, women and children-are making more money than they ever did before, through working on their own roads and highways, which were found in pretty much the same condition a when they were cut by the wheels of Joab's chariot. The pecple of Pales-tine were without their staples of fice and sugar for almost three years but now have ample stores of wheat They are now not only living, but learning how to live in a broader and more ambitious form than they were ever able to realize before.
