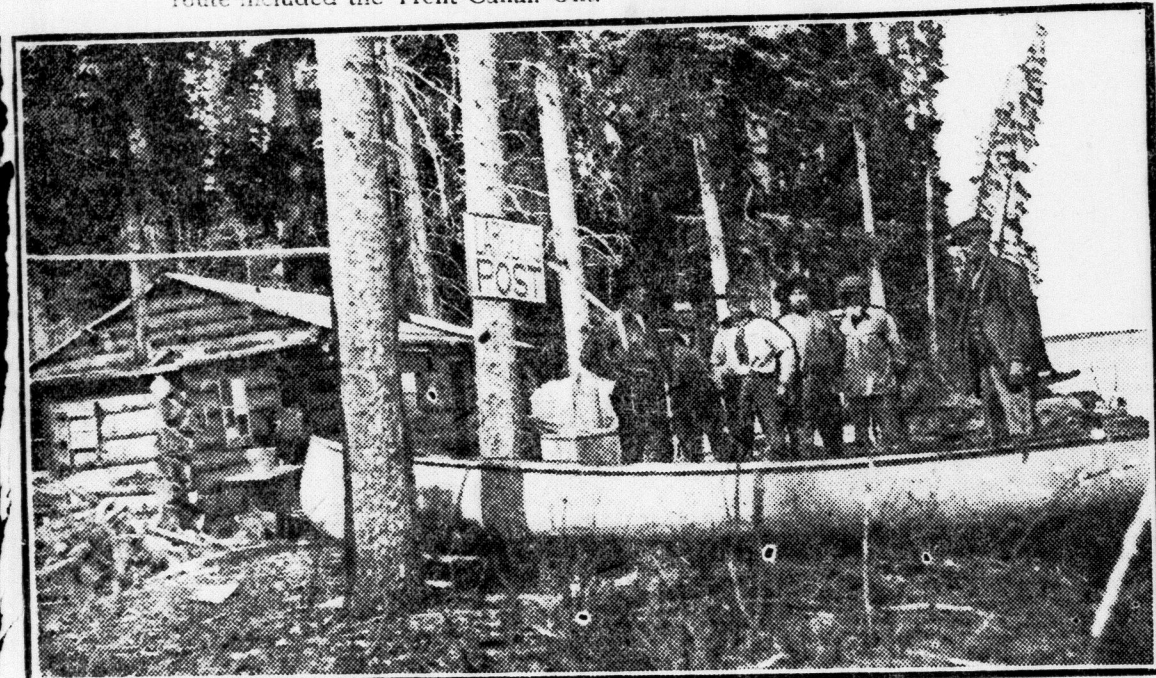

Dwight F. Davis, assistant United States secretary of war, who, it is stated, is slated to succeed John W. Weeks as head of the war department.



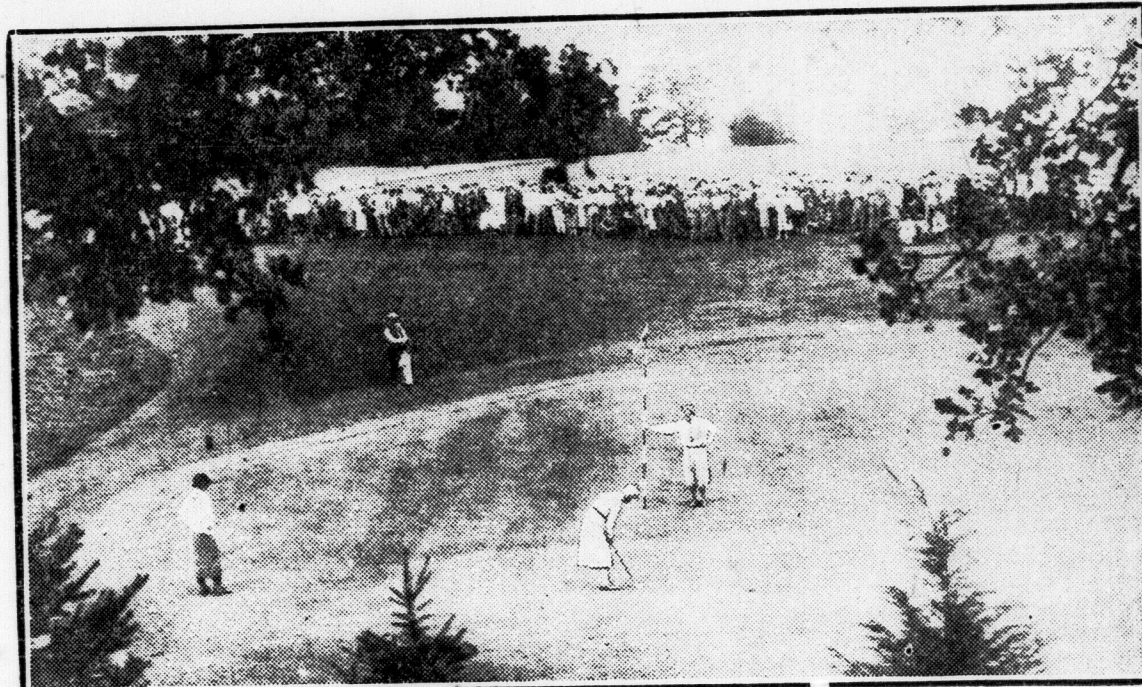

One of the canoe trips on Peace river, where the Indians barter their furs for supplies.



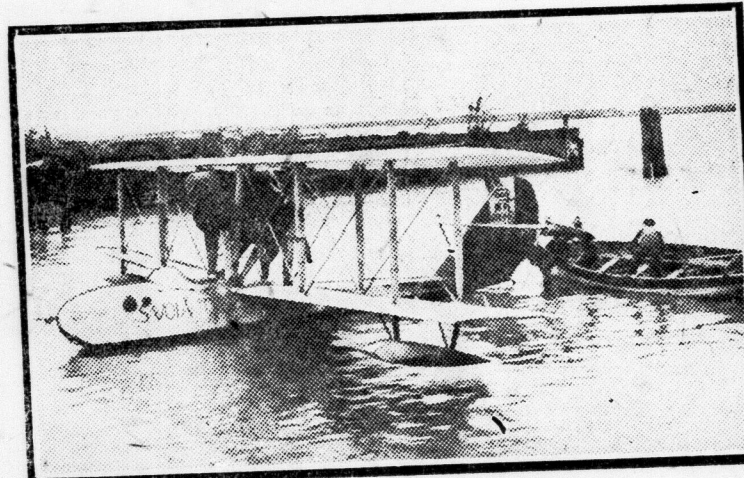
New photo of Col. William Mitchell, snapped with his wife at the United States aviation probe.



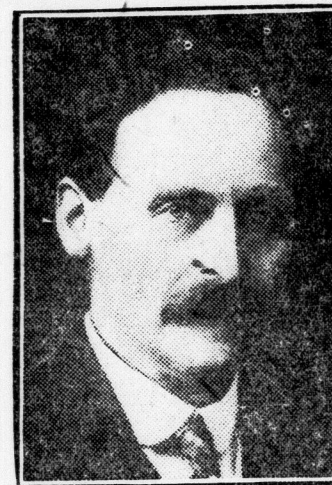

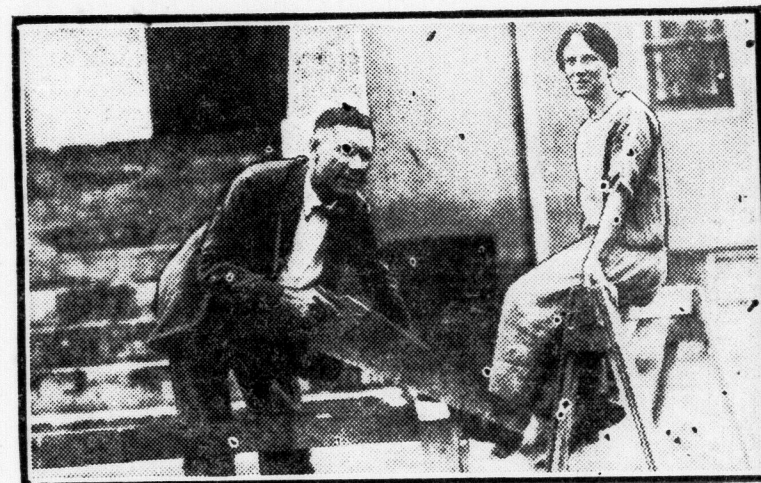

Hydroplane in which two Italian airmen, Commander Francesco de Pinedo and Sr. Campanelli, are flying around the world.

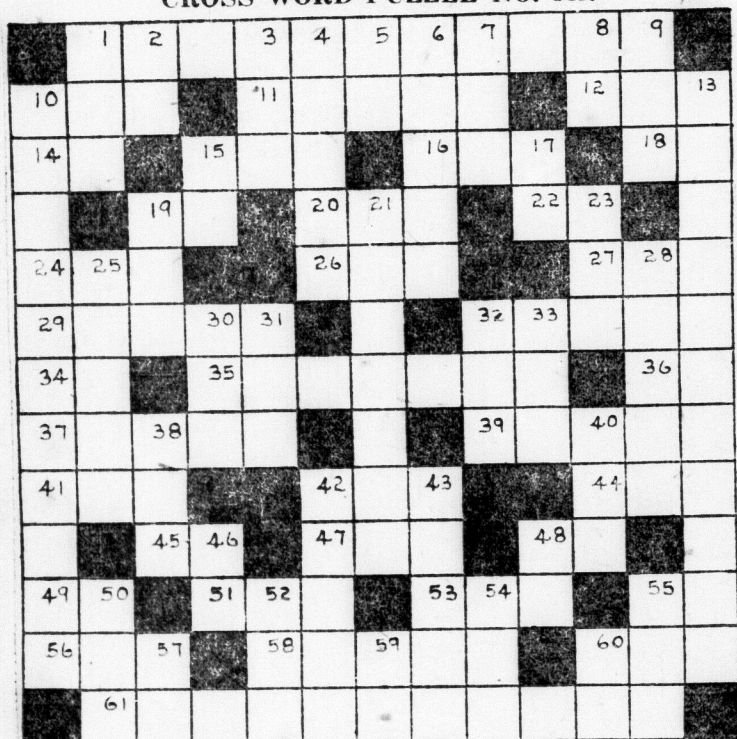


Lord Dawson of Penn, physician of the king, who, with Lady Dawson and their daughter, has arrived in Canada.

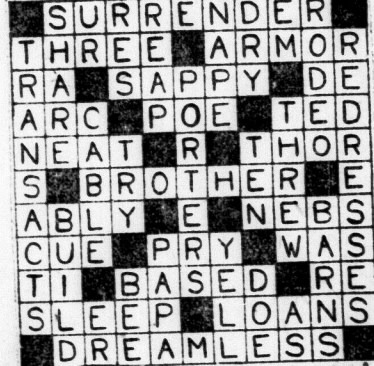

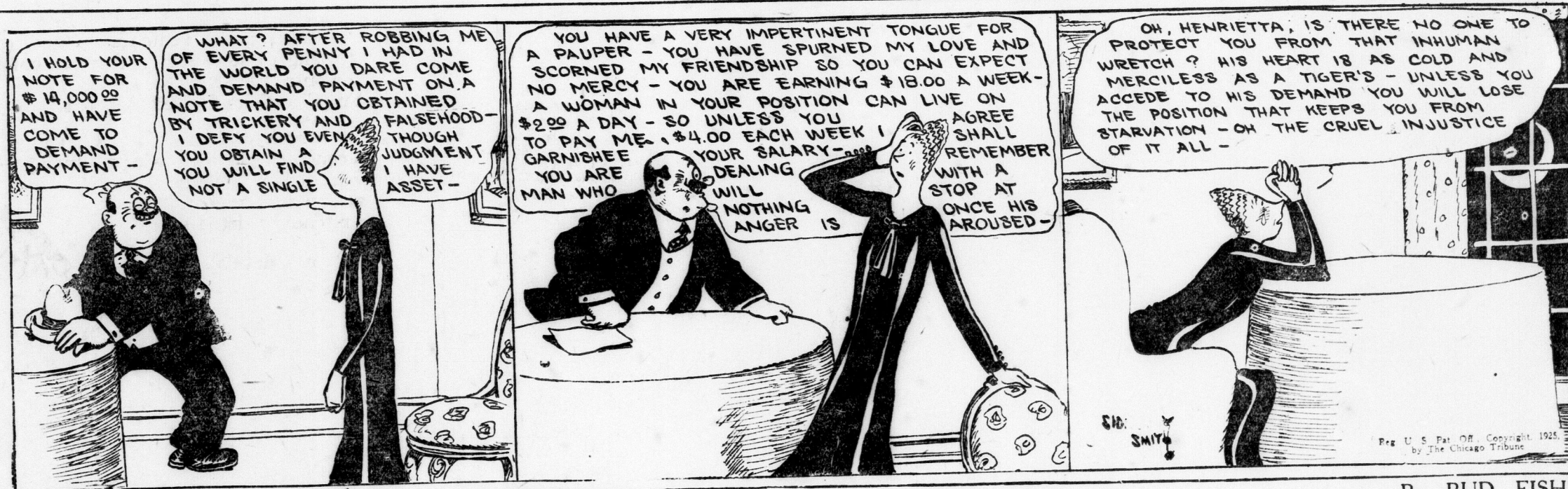
