COSTS THOUSANDS TO MOVE TEAMS

C. P. R. Under Heavy Expense in Sending Trains via C. N. R.

Thousands of dollars are being paid by the Canadian Pacific Railway to provide an emergency service for its patrons each day that freight conditions keep the C. P. R.'s short route from Montreal to St. John blocked at Danforth, Me.

Latest reports indicate that it will be the first of next week before the C. P. R. have their own through line from Montreal to St. John in operation. Meanwhile it is taking forty-two instead of seventeen hours for passengers to reach Fredericton from Montreal with the Quebec and St. John is concerned in trips from Montreal not so great, but the C. P. R. has maintained an uninterrupted service for its patrons despite the great cost.
