The most noticeable speech of the day was made by Mr. Teller (Rep., Colo.), in which he discountenanced the practice of taunting Democratic Senators with inconsistency. They had explained, he said, the cause of their inconsistency, and their defence was absolute and perfect. He declared that he would join them in putting the bill through in the best possible shape, that the bill was ample for the protection of American industries, and that it was a better bill than he had expected, or than any which the Rehe had expected, or than any which the Re-publican side of the chamber had hoped to
