SUPPLEMENTARY.

I supplement the foregoing list of works relating to the Pioneers predecessor by adding thereto a copy of Catlin's "Manners, Customs and Condition of the North American Indians, with Four Hundred Illustrations, carefully engraved from his Original Paintings, and Coloured after Nature." I also add to the mention made of usages and forms of speech derived from the Indians among Canadian youngsters aforetime, a mode of reproducing at pleasure the Indian war-whoop. This was done by uttering a long yell interrupted by a rapid succession of smart strokes against the mouth by the palm of the hand.
