- AGGETT, WILLIAM HARVEY;** *C.F.A., Gnr., Bdr.; Can. Inf., Lieut.; Injured, July 1916; Killed in Action, Passchendaele, Nov. 6, 1917.*
- ALBRIGHT, FREDERICK STANLEY;** *Can. Inf., Pte., Sergt., Pte.; Killed in Action, Passchendaele, Oct. 26, 1917.*
- ALLISON, JOHN OLIVER;** *Can. Inf., Lieut.; Killed in Action May 1918.*
- AMSDEN, WILLIAM GEORGE;** *Can. Inf., Lieut., Capt.; Killed in Action Aug. 8, 1918.*
- ANDERSON, FREDERICK JOHN;** *Can. Inf., Lieut.; Killed in Action Oct. 28, 1917.*
- ANDREW, WILFRED BISSELL;** *C.F.A., Gnr.; Can. Inf., Lieut.; R.F.C.; Killed in Action Feb. 1917.*
- ANNIS, WILBUR F.;** *Can. Inf., Lieut.; R.F.C.—Flt. Cmdr.; Wounded Dec. 1916; Died from injuries at Camp Borden, May 4, 1918.*
- BARBER, PERCY LOUIS;** *Can. Inf., Lieut.; Wounded Sept. 21, 1916, May 21, 1917; Killed in Action, Passchendaele, Nov. 8, 1917.*
- BARKER, JOSEPH CLAUDE ANTHONY;** *C.A.D.C., Sergt.; R.A.F., Lieut.; Accidentally killed June 7, 1918.*
- BAUER, WILFRED ROBERT;** *C.F.A., Gnr., Bdr., Lieut.; Inv.; Mil. Repres., M.D. 1 (M.S.A.); Died at Waterloo Oct. 11, 1918.*
- BEATON, GROVER CLEVELAND;** *U. of T. O/S. Tr. Coy., Pte.; R.G.A. Sec. Lieut., Lieut.; Died from gas poisoning Sept. 1, 1918.*
- BERRY, GEORGE HERBERT;** *C.A.M.C., Pte.; R.F.A., Sec. Lieut.; Wounded Oct. 6, 1917; Died of wounds Oct. 9, 1917.*
- BINNS, PERCY VERA;** *C.E., Lieut., Staff Capt.; Wounded Sept. 8, 1916; M.C., Jan. 1, 1917; Killed in Action, near Arras, Aug. 28, 1918.*
- BIRD, MONTAGU HERRBERT;** *Can. Inf., Lieut.; R.F.C.; R.A.F.; Died of wounds July 9, 1918.*
