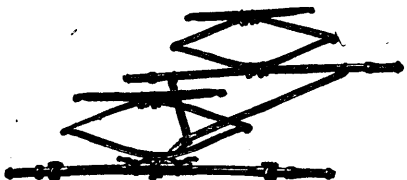

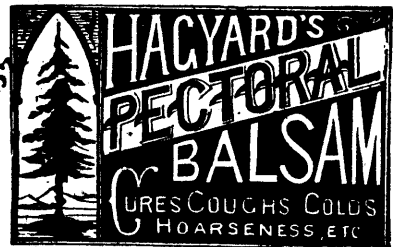

Household Hints.

FIG CAKE.—Two cups of sugar, three-fourths of a cup of butter, whites of six eggs, one cup of milk, one pound of chopped figs, one cup of corn starch, two cups of flour, two teaspoonfuls of baking powder.

BROILED CHICKEN.—Split the chicken open on the back, and then flatten with a cleaver; lay in a dripping-pan with the inside of the chicken next the pan; bake one hour, and baste occasionally; when done, make a gravy with the giblets, a little butter and browned flour.

CRANBERRY PIE.—For the pastry, take one quart of flour, half a pound of lard, half a pound of butter, one cup of cold water. Wash and pick over the berries. Put into a saucepan with a little water, and simmer until they become soft. Bake with a cross-bar of pastry over the top.

CURRIED CHICKEN.—Cut a chicken into pieces, season and fry in butter. Slice an onion, and fry in butter, add a teaspoonful of stock, and a tablespoonful of curry powder mixed with a little flour and rubbed smooth with a little stock; salt; boil five minutes.

COCOANUT CAKE.—Take an ordinary amount of dough, one cup of desiccated cocoanut; mix thoroughly; bake in three layers. Put together with frosting in which has been thoroughly mixed one tablespoonful of cocoanut. Frost the cake; sprinkle the top heavily with cocoanut.
