## MINING NEWS.

Victoria, B.C., July 11, '99.

The steamer Willapa brings news of the discovery of rich gold-bearing sand at Wreck Bay, about five miles from Ucluelet on the west corst of Vancouver Island. Large deposits of black sand are found all along the beach in the vicinity of Ucluelet and a casual panning by an old-time prospector a few days ago revealed the fact that its sand is rich in gold.

The news soon spread, and the beach had all been staked off for miles in either direction by the settlers. With only the crudest oppliances of some manufacture, the sand is yielding \$9 a day the man. A prospector who came over from Clayoquet to test the truth of the report, took one pan of sand from the beach, carried it down to the water, and as a result of his labors got \$2.50 from the one pan.

The fact of the discovery is vouched for by a number of people arriving by the Willapa who saw the gold being washed out.
