F. Fauguer is held in the neighborhood.

The Parochial Association of Huntingdon also begs to acknowledge special donations of £11 16s. 5d. to be applied for Church purposes in that parish.

Your Committee regret the inefficiency of the Depository for the sale of Bibles, Prayer Books, &c., during the past year. Efforts will be made to secure more efficient assistance, and a regular supply of books.

NOVA SCOTIA.

In the Legislative Council on Friday last, the Lord Bishop in his place introduced a Bill for incorporating the Diocese of Nova Scotia. The object of the Bill is to enable the Diocesan Church Society to hold and to manage real estate belonging to the Diocese, and to give it the power to acquire property in accordance with the principles of the measure, though some objections have been made, as our readers will perceive, with reference to its details. The Bill was read a first time, and was referred to a select Committee—the Lord Bishop, Mr. B. H. Allen, Mr. B. H. Allen, Mr. B. H. Allen, and Mr. B. H. Allen. A Bill for incorporating the Diocesan Church Society was read.
