Conclusion

While recognizing that in all of these cases the functional organizations described above were formed to fit a specific need, often within a designated time-frame and limited mandate, they represent practical and operational applications of the concepts of verification that have been outlined in this paper. The missing ingredients needed to apply these concepts to the effective solution of arms control problems currently before the CD are two: political will and financial support. Given the determination of member nations individually and collectively, neither of these should pose an insurmountable problem.
